5. There will be a Valentine Photobooth with backdrops and add-on materials.
6. The following are the mechanics of the contest:
  - a. Class group pictures of those who availed composed of any or all of the following:
    1. 5 learners + class adviser's groupie
    2. 6 learners' groupie
    3. the remaining number of learners' (6 and below) groupie
    4. 5-7 teachers' or 5-7 parents' groupie
    5. combination of 5-7 teachers and parents' groupie
  - b. Photo projection will depend on how the participants pose, smile, and/or use the booth add-on materials.
